The Mental Health Litigation Division of the Committee for Public Counsel Services is accepting applications for “Regional Coordinators” for the twelve-month period from March 1, 2012 to February 28, 2013. Responsibilities will include providing advice and technical assistance to assigned counsel in mental health proceedings, reviewing and monitoring the performance of counsel, investigating complaints as to attorney performance, conducting and/or coordinating eight (8) hours of continuing legal education programs for assigned counsel, and serving as liaison to local courts. Please note that these are contractual positions and that the total hours under each will vary according to location and the number of assigned counsel served.

Applicants must possess the following minimum qualifications: membership in the Massachusetts bar; current CPCS Mental Health Litigation certification; extensive trial experience, including a minimum of five years mental health litigation experience; and the ability to maintain good relationships with fellow attorneys and judicial personnel.
