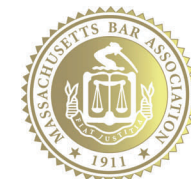


Directions to Worcester Courthouse:

From Boston--I-90W to Exit 10A (Worcester) (I-290W). At end of ramp, take 1st right onto Rt. 20, then slight right onto Rt. 146N. Take Exit 13 onto I290 (Shrewsbury). Take Exit 16 (MLK Jr. Blvd/Downtown). Turn left onto E. Central St. (becomes MLK). Turn left to stay on MLK. Turn right onto Main St.

From West-I-90E to Auburn/Worcester exit. Take I-290E into Worcester. Take Exit 16. At bottom of ramp, turn left onto Central St./MLK Jr. Blvd to 5th traffic light. Turn right onto Main St., Courthouse is on right.

From South-Take I-495N to Exit 25B (I-290W). Take Exit 18 (Rt. 9/Lincoln Sq.). Take right onto Lincoln St., (becomes Worcester Center Blvd). Turn right onto School St., then left onto Main St., Courthouse is on the right.
