Closing arguments are a critical part of your advocacy for your client in a family regulation trial. Giving a powerful closing feels great and can be a lot of fun! You create a roadmap for the judge to arrive at your desired outcome with your argument. Your client is almost certainly living in poverty, powerless against this behemoth of a system, and likely a member of another marginalized group. Closing arguments are a way to tell your client's story in the most authentic way and honor their experience. This session will provide guidance on how and when to write your closing most effectively, how to make your delivery as powerful as possible, and demonstrate these skills in action.
